After successfully completing the shipment of over 5,400 drums of Depleted Uranium Oxide waste in 2008 from the US Department of Energy (DOE) Savannah River Site one month ahead of schedule, DOE awarded Cavanagh Services Group, Inc. (“Cavanagh”) a second contract for the remaining volume of the DUO drums.

This additional contract comes under the American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (“ARRA”) Program and requires Cavanagh to ship the remaining 14,800 drums by rail to an offsite licensed disposal facility. The expanded scope of work includes providing an on-site logistics expert to oversee the preparation of the drums, loading of the railcars, development of project plans, and serving as the liaison with both the railroad and the disposal companies. In business for seven (7) years, Cavanagh has transported over 5 million miles of hazardous material by both rail and truck with no safety incidents.
